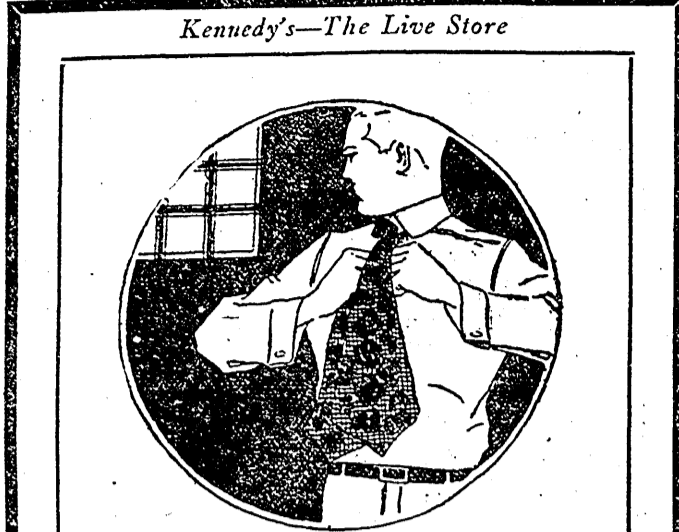

Autopsy on Body of Girl Who Dropped Dead Shows Heart Was Normal

VICTIM DAUGHTER OF R. I. POLICE OFFICER
